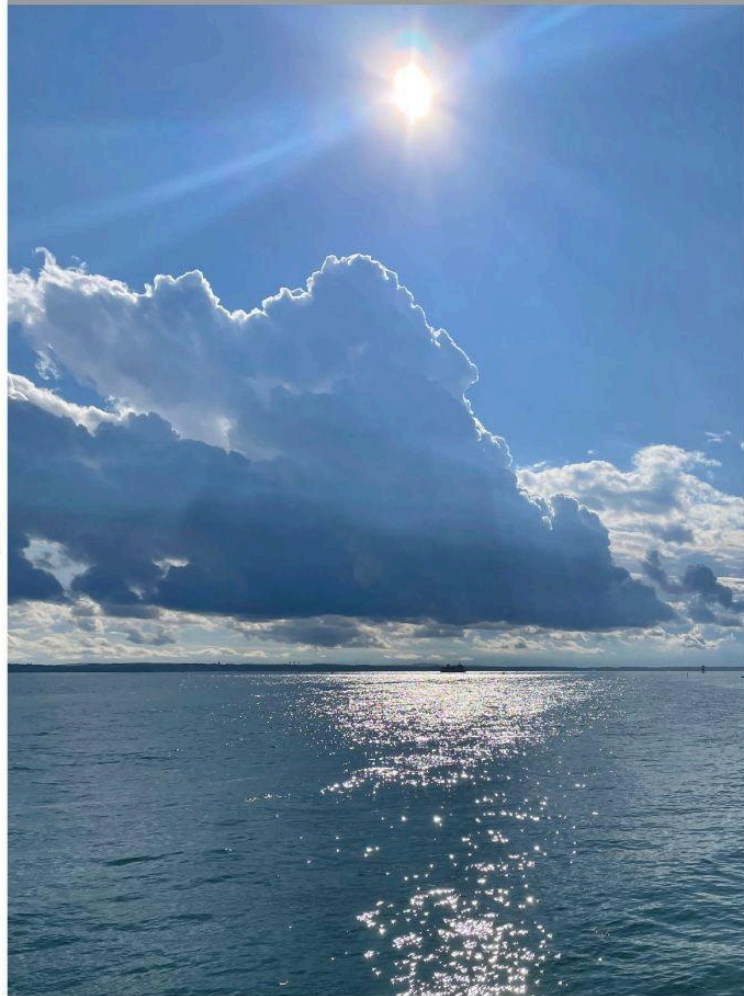

Congratulations also to Ingrid who scored maximum points at a recent Horndean Camera Club competition.

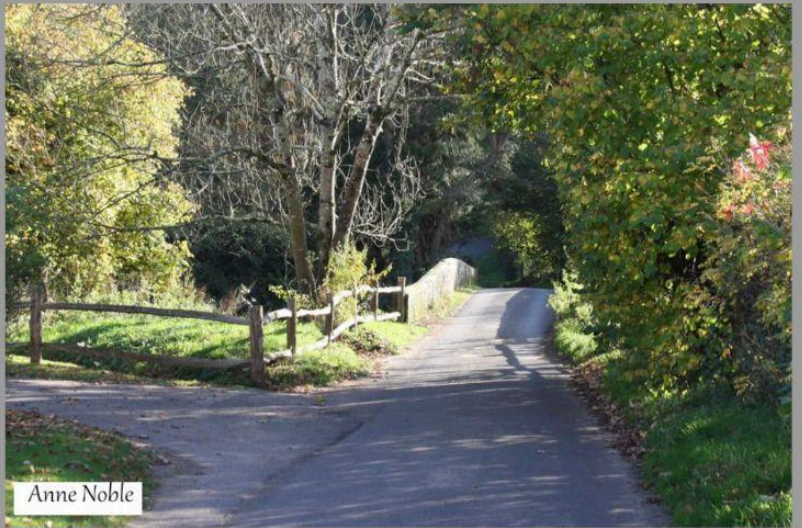

Our November theme was "Shadows" and a few of your pictures follow.





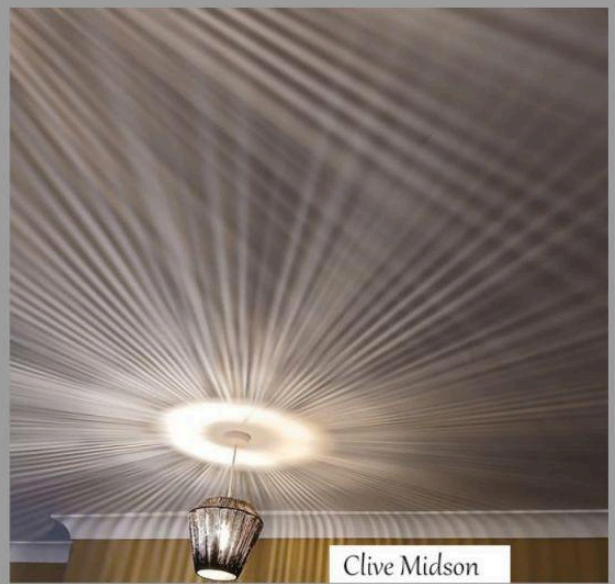

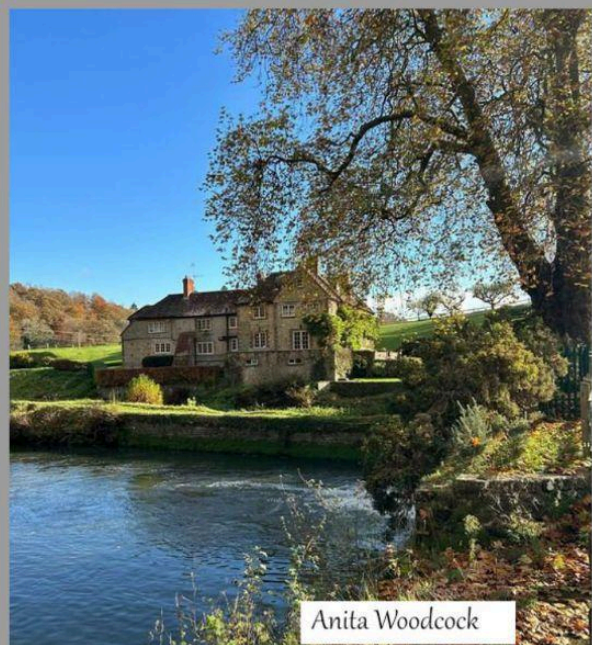
For our November meeting we paid a visit to the Sussex village of Stedham, between Petersfield and Midhurst where we enjoyed some fine Autumnal weather.



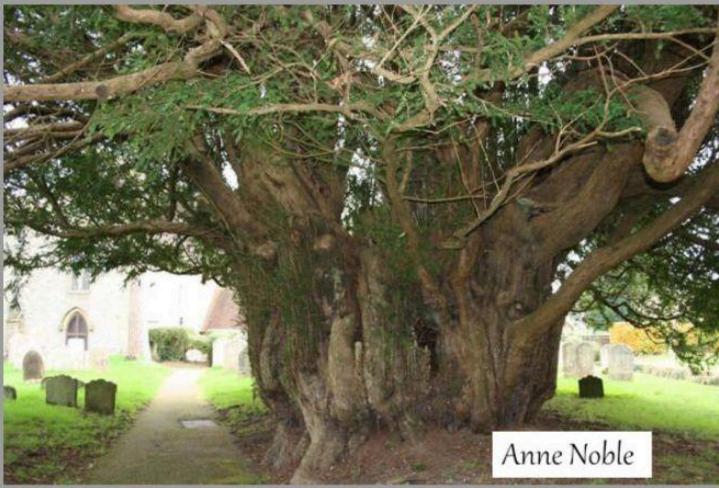
