

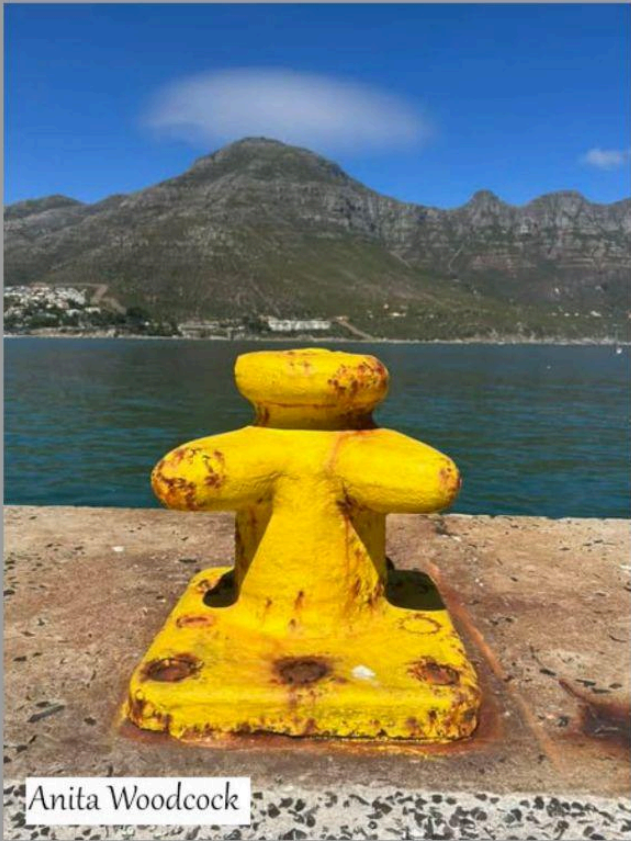
Newsletter March 2025

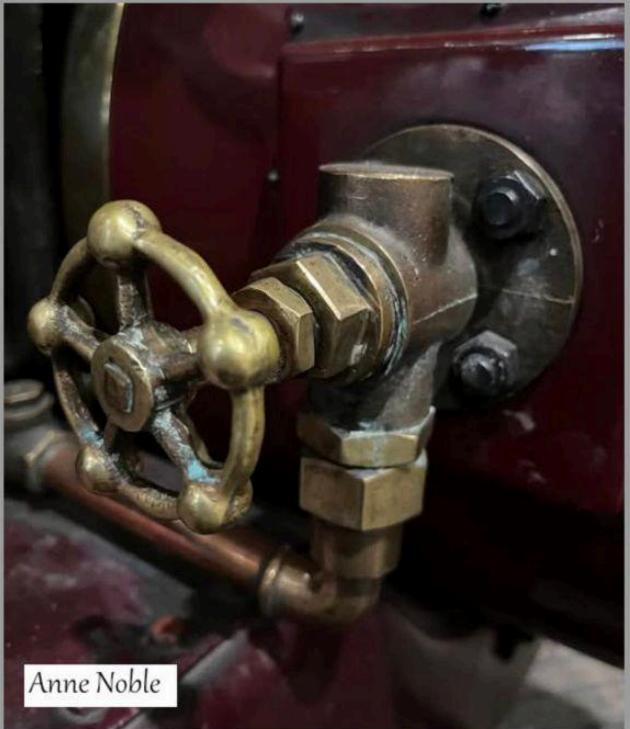
Our theme for February was "Joint(s)" and after a slow start the entries came flooding in with varying degrees of skill and tastefulness.
