Our theme last month was "Liquid" and as usual there was a good variety of interpretations posted to our Facebook page.



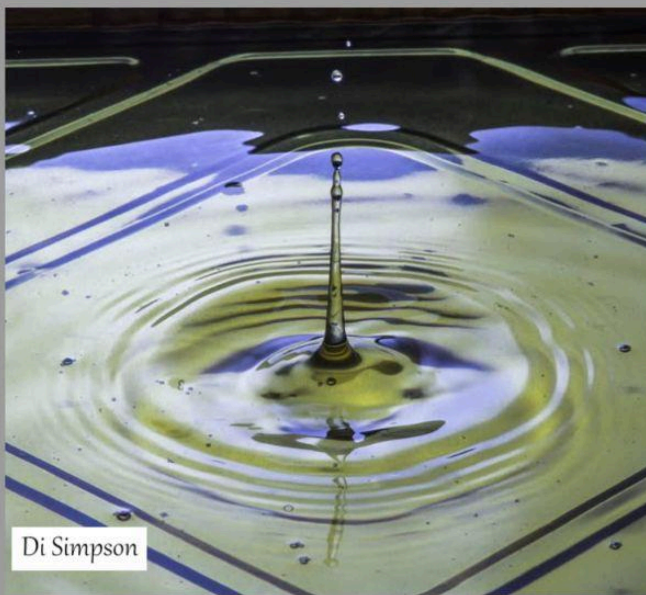

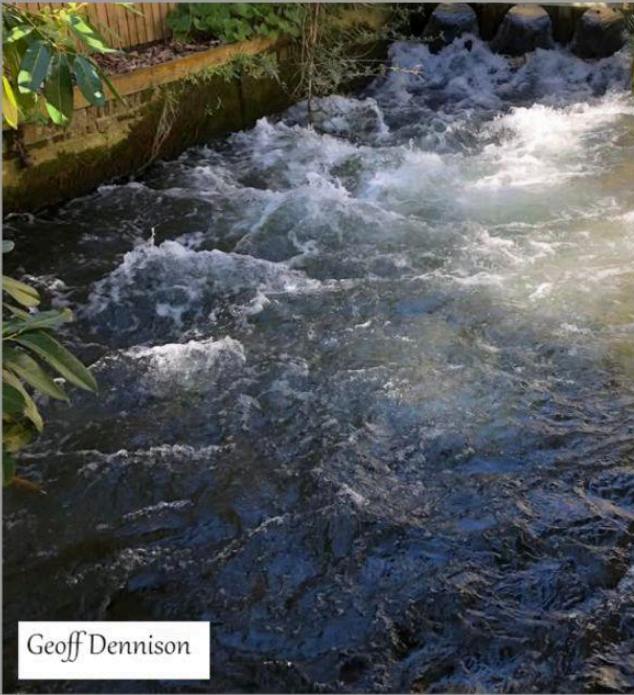

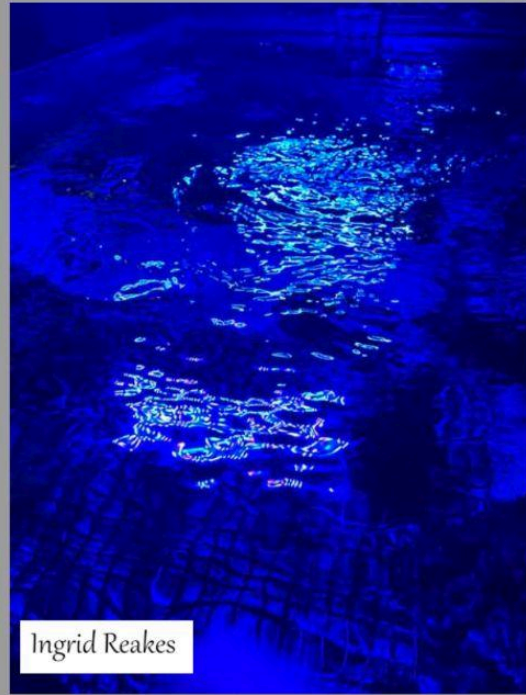
