Didn't we have a lovely day....?

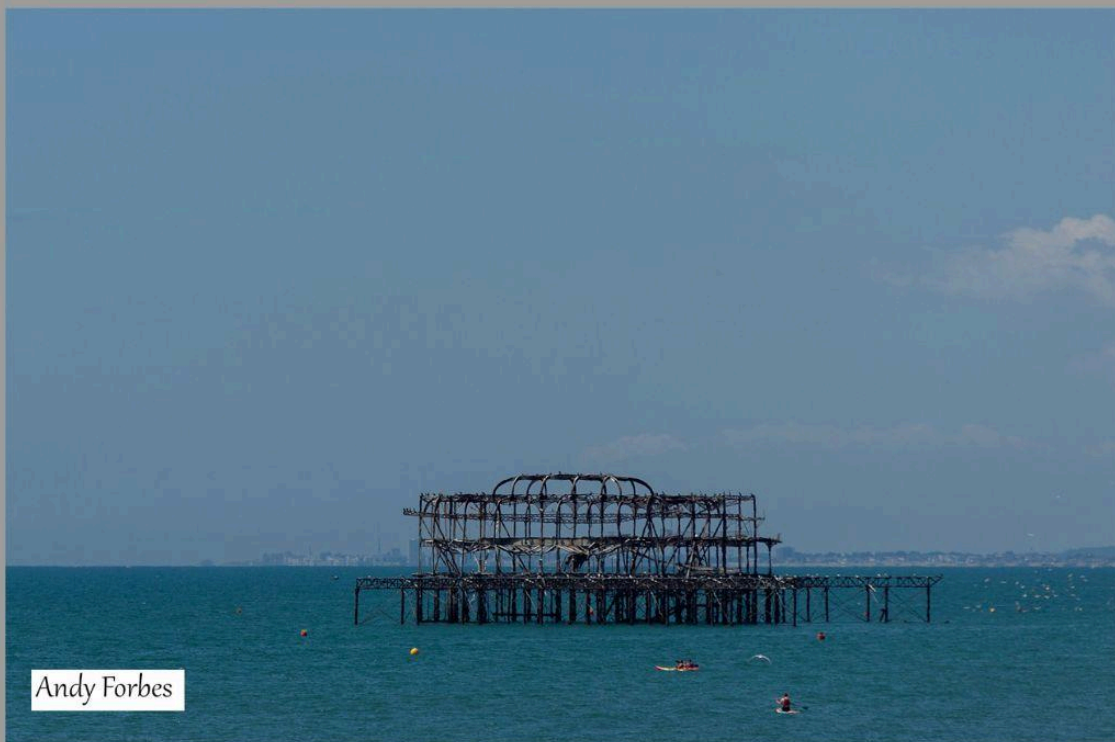


Guess who managed to find the wine shop in Brighton.....
