

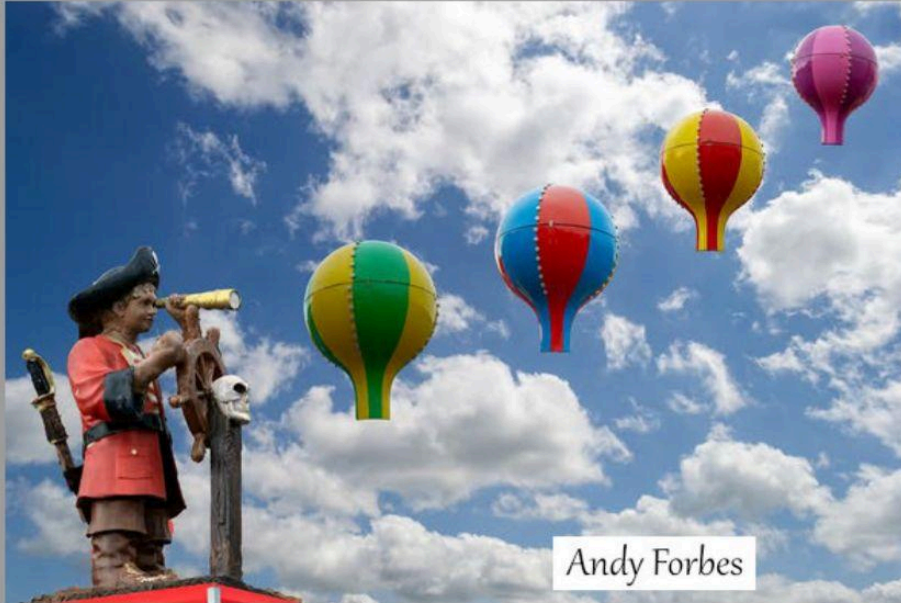
## Newsletter April 2026

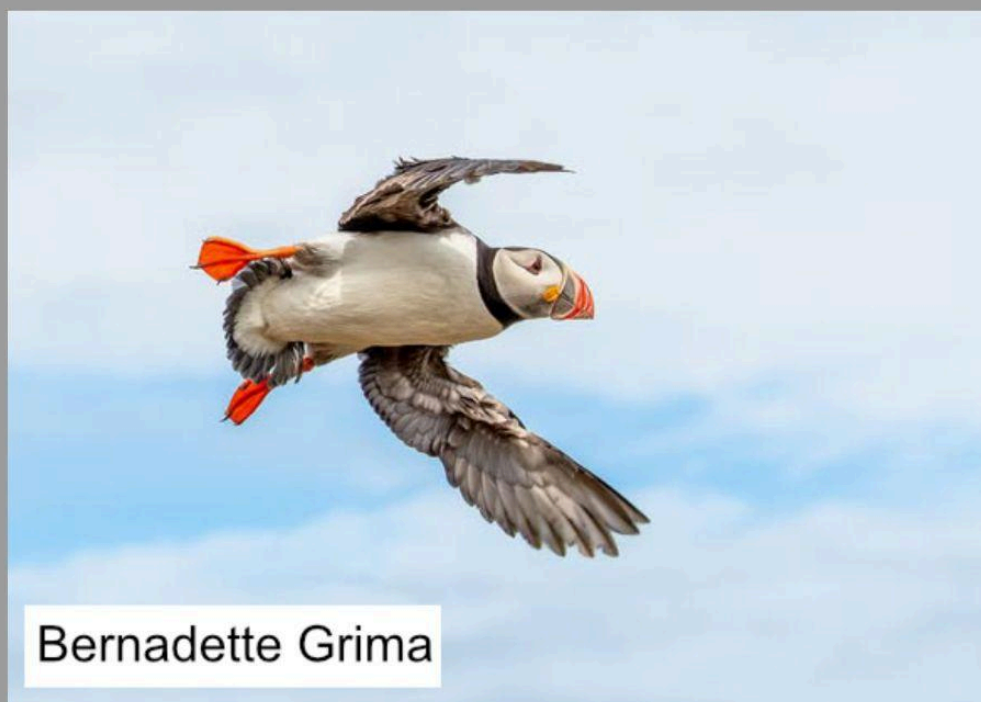
